Student Lounge Policies

The following policies are in effect for any student who uses the Student Lounge, located on the second floor of the Music Building:

- Students will be mindful that the Music Student Lounge is not a replacement for, or extension of, the student's office or practice room.
- Student are responsible for any belongings they leave in the Music Student Lounge.

For students who have requested after-hours access to the Student Lounge, the following policies are in effect:

- Students are not permitted to give the Music Student Lounge access code to anyone else – this includes current music students, non-music students, or music students who have graduated.
- Students are to shut the door when they are in the Music Student Lounge and be sure it is shut when they leave.
- If you are in the Music Student Lounge after hours and someone without the code wants to come in, you are not to let them in.
- Students are not permitted to sleep in, or stay overnight in, the Music Student Lounge.
- Even one violation of this policy will mean everyone loses after-hours access.
