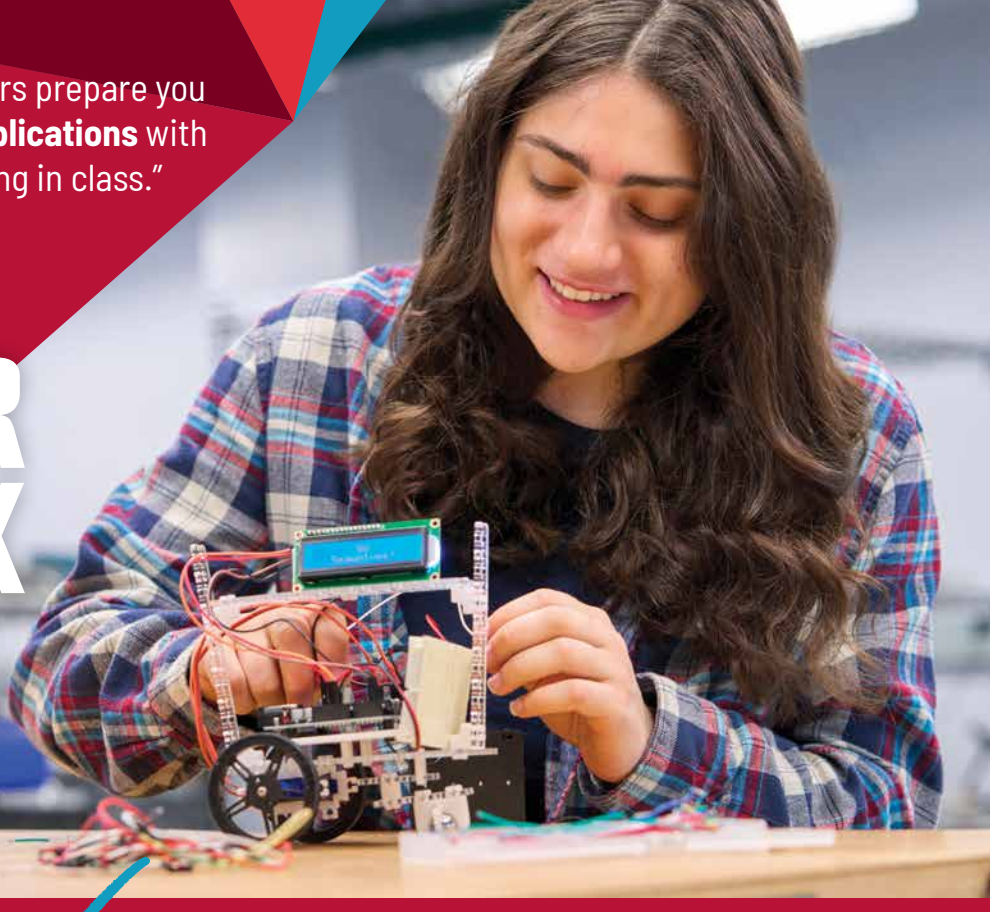
freedom to make our own experiment and try something different than everyone else. That really opened up my point of view and made me realize that I can pursue what I want to find out about through my own research.”

Having a close-working relationship with them has opened a lot of doors for me in terms of my own personal research and pursuits.”
